



Final remarks by the Assessors C.U. Shah Medical College, Surendranagar, Gujarat

- Compliance Verification Assessment of the physical and the other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of M.B.B.S. degree (100 seats) granted by Saurashtra University, Rajkot in respect of students being trained at C.U. Shah Medical College, Surendranagar, Gujarat was done on 27th August, 2014.
- Since it was a compliance verification, a detailed evaluation was not done for the following areas:
 - (a) During the assessment the clinical material, faculty count and general evaluation of the infrastructure was seen as per verbal instructions from MCI.
 - (b) The health centers, detailed infrastructure, peripheral services, hostels and accommodation etc were not visited during the assessment.
 - (c) The land records, permissions etc were not evaluated during the assessment

These would have been done in previous assessments. However only a general survey and assessments for the various details were evaluated as per verbal instructions.

- The assessment team reached the college at 9.30 am and met the Dean,
- The distribution of work by the individual team members was as under:
 Dr Achal Gulati: Visited the clinical to evaluate the clinical material and other infrastructure available in the hospital
 - Dr. S.K. Dhattarwal visited the Pre and Para clinical departments, hostels. Both the assessors jointly verified the faculty members of the college..
- An attendance sheet was circulated amongst all the faculty and staff to mark
 the signatures by 11.00 am. It was informed that only those who were present
 at that time would be evaluated in the afternoon at the time of physical
 verification.



- The assessment process was videographed using 2 videographers, one with each assessor.
- Dean Office: The College has adequate infrastructure for the administrative wing of the Dean and the ancillary staff.
- Web Site: The College has a web site with the needed information, but it needs to be updated to include its most recent contents.
- UG Intake: The College is permitted and recognized for an intake of 100 students.
- PG Courses: The College is conducting post graduate courses in most subjects as detailed in main report.
- The ME unit, college council, Pharmacological Vigilance committee etc are in place.
- Nursing staff: As per the details available, there are 248 nursing staff available and this list has been given and certified by the Dean and Medical Superintendent.
- The OPD's are located in the hospital building in the same campus. The OPD rooms are spacious and have the OPD areas have designated teaching areas. Each OPD has 4 rooms with facilities for routine examinations. Some OPD's need waiting space expansions.
- Injection rooms, dressing room, minor OT, refraction rooms as related to the various departments are available.
- Operation theatres: Approx 25-30 major and about 35-40 minor cases are
 operated per day amongst the various OT's. The OT's are newly constructed
 and each department are accommodated in separate modules, each having
 the theatre, changing rooms, record room, store, pre and post operative
 rooms. They are centrally air conditioned and have central oxygen and
 suction. 8 such complexes are available and are distributed as follows 1 table
 each for ENT, Ophthalmology, Orthopedics, Implantology, and septic OT and



2 OT's each in the complex for General Surgery, Obs/Gyn, Caualty in each complex

- The wards: are constructed as per the requirements.
- Clinical material: The clinical material is adequate, genuine and of good clinical value. The daily OPD is around 1200 patients per day and the occupancy is around 80%. The clinical laboratory and radiology load is adequate.
- The labour rooms, ICU's, Casualty, emergency services with 20 beds are available and adequate.
- Blood bank: A licensed blood bank is available for whole blood and component separation.
- . The RHTC and the UHTC are available but the assessors did not visit them.
- The faculty members and residents which have not been counted have been detailed as above.
