1	<p>On detailed examination of patients, 21 patients were observed to have anal pathology. On random examination of patients per anally they did not have the pathology as written in the case paper. 13 patients had pain abdomen under investigation or peptic ulcer disease but no investigation had been done for 4 to 5 days indicating that the patients did not need indoor admission. 32 patients in Orthopaedics had backache and Osteoarthritis not meriting admission copy of evidence sheet and photographs of case sheets attached. Deducting 66 patients from total admission the total number of genuine patients is 504, i.e. 70%. Resultantly, bed occupancy of genuine patients was 70%.</p>	<p>As per our records the total patients admitted in the hospital was 626 patients (87% of 720 beds) at 10 AM. Our records and the assessors finding differ due to patient referrals (56 patients) to the other different departments for investigation and other management like X-ray/USG/MRI/CT/ NTR Vaidyaseva registration purposes. The assessment team has deducted 66 patients to arrive at the total bed occupancy of 70% from a total 570 patients instead of the aforementioned 626 patients. If the same is considered on 626 patients, the total bed occupancy will be 77% (which is $626-66=560$; $560/720=77\%$).</p> <p>Further, the assessor has included in the assessment report that 32 patients in the Orthopedics department who were</p>	<p>Bed occupancy was 82.91% (597 /720) on the day of assessment.</p>





The admission was given to offer relief from the above pain and symptoms and investigations for further surgical management of the patients. Notes:**For purpose of working out the deficiency:**

(1) The deficiency of teaching faculty and Resident Doctors shall be counted separately.

(A) For Teaching Faculty:

- (a) For calculating the deficiency of faculty, Prof., Assoc Prof., Asst. Prof & Tutor in respective departments shall be counted together.
- (b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
- (c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/ category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
- (d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.

(B) For Resident Doctors:

- (a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
- (b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
- (c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
- (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.
