There was no deficiency in bed occupancy on the day of assessment as the actual bed occupancy was 72%. Total available number of patients was 217 on the day of assessment. The assessors might have visited and/or not visited certain areas of the hospital leading to erroneous deductions in bed occupancy. They have taken into account only the patients lying on bed and did not count the already admitted patients who were sent for procedures, investigations, waiting to be discharged, went to wash rooms etc. Also, the patients admitted on the day of assessment after 10.00 AM were not taken into account. 4	The patients in OPD were few, number of patients did not match the register as data seemed to be inflated	The OPD patients first report to main reception for the registration and then on the basis of their medical problems they are guided to report to respective OPDs where they are attended by the doctors of respective specialty. From there, majority of patients go for investigations either to Central Laboratory or to the department of Radio-diagnosis. Some of the patients who do not need any investigation may directly go to Pharmacy to get medicines while other patients on the advice of attending doctors, report for admission in respective wards or critical units. As the OPD patients moves to different units/places of the hospital as per their requirements, the number of patients varies in different places of the hospital at different times on a given day. But by no means are the total number of OPD patients happens to be less than MCI requirement on any day. The OPD attendance was 869 up to 2.00 PM and 900 upto 4.00 at the end of OPD timings on the day of assessment which was in consonance with record in the register on that day.
