(2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/city and run by the same management.
(3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations - 2000.



There are 530 teaching beds distributed among 17 units in this hospital. In addition, we utilize the clinical facilities at the Government hospitals namely: Government District Wenlock Hospital (GDWH) and Lady Goschen Hospital (LGH). GDWH has 570 teaching beds distributed among 19 units and LGH has 90 beds distributed among 3 units. We have had this arrangement with government hospitals since the inception of the college (1955) and it has been functioning smoothly.</p> <p>The two government hospitals namely Government District Wenlock Hospital and Lady Goschen Hospital were constructed during the British rule and have a rich history of more than 150 years. Hence, in these hospitals the distance between beds is a challenge. In spite of this huge challenge, we are happy to inform you that we have been able to re-arrange the beds in such a manner that the distance between beds is now more than 1.5 metres without reducing the number of beds.</p> <p>We wish to humbly state that the wards are as per MSR regulations and adhere to almost all the requirements laid down by the Medical Council of India. The same has been verified by the assessment team and documented on pages 12-13 of Part A-II form.</p> <p>The assessment team has stated that "Teaching space</p>	<p>between 2 beds required as per regulations (&lt; 1.5m) is not uniformly done. Hence, even though the wards have a demonstration room, the team leader felt that it would not accommodate 25 students. We would like to submit that at no time the number of students for clinical discussion in a batcha is more than 15. The available demonstration room can accommodate these students. However, we have now increased the space available for teaching in many of these wards. Further, the Minimum Standard Requirements for the Medical College for 250 Admissions Annually Regulations, 1999 (Amended – Up To July 2015) only mandates the presence of Clinical Demonstration Room. There is no specific requirement with respect to either size or capacity. We wish to humbly submit that we have adequate teaching space to carry out teaching activities in the attached hospitals.</p>

We informed this to the team leader and also showed him the document from the District Medical Officer regarding the same. We have attached the letter from the District Medical Officer as Annexure 1.</p> <p>In the year 2015, the department of General Surgery has performed 3,967 major operations and 10,971 minor operations.
