With respect to above subject and reference, I would like to bring to kind notice the following facts:

1. During the compliance assessment of 3rd renewal of Sambhram Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kolar Gold Fields (KGF), Karnataka on 11 April 2019, the assessors have assessed the bed occupancy and arrived at 71% arbitrarily without actual counting the bed occupancy. But actually the bed occupancy was 81%. And they also have commented that 95% of patients did not have any treatment going on or investigations done but in actual this is not true as all the patients did have the treatment and the investigations were done or asked for. The inspectors did not allow comment on this in the SIF III form.
 2. There was both assembly and parliament elections scheduled on the day of inspection (11th April) in the neighboring state therefore some faculty (5) and some residents (6) were on leave to caste their vote who were not considered and not counted on the day of assessment.
 3. Some faculty and residents were not considered even though they were present during assessment.
- Kindly consider the above facts, while considering the granting of the permission for 3rd Renewal.

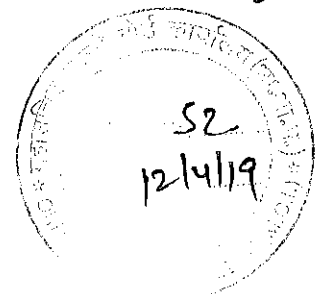

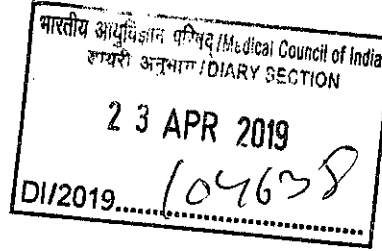

Sub: Verification of Compliance for 4th Batch (3rd Renewal) MBBS Admission at Sambhram Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Kolar Gold Fields, Karnataka - Submission of our explanation to the observations made by the Assessors.

We thank you immensely for deputing the Assessors, Dr. Apurva G Shah, Dr. Neeta Bachlaus and Dr. Lakshmi Kameshwari, for verification of compliance of 4th Batch (3rd renewal) of MBBS admission at our College on 11th April 2019.

At this juncture, we would like to submit our explanation and clarify about the observations made by the Assessors in the assessors' report.

1. Biometric machines: We have sent two reminders to MCI to install the biometric machines. However, no one has visited our College to install the machines so far. The same comment is repeated in every inspection. Hence, we humbly request to kindly depute the biometric installation team at the earliest. Copies of our reminder letters attached. **Annexure - 1**

2. Bed Occupancy (71%) and Clinical Material : The actual bed occupancy on the day of assessment was 81% (332 patients/410 beds) whereas the assessors have considered bed occupancy as 71% arbitrarily without actual count. The assessors also have not gone through all the individual case sheets which had diagnosis, treatment, various investigation reports etc. Treatment was going on for all patients admitted in the various wards. Patients requiring special care and treatment was also in progress.

Some patients' investigations reports were awaited as they were waiting for signatures of lab reports and hence delayed. The treating doctors got the test results orally and the treatment was started. Example: One patient who came with fever, his vital test results were awaited, but the treatment had already begun.

By the time the Assessors reached the Post-operative ward, the surgeries were going on in the Operation theatre and these patients were not counted. The post-operative patients who had gone to physiotherapy or x-ray were also not counted. OT list attached.

As the patients' visiting hours are at 12.00 noon to 2.00 p.m. No visitors were permitted in the Ward.

There was 1 normal delivery and 1 caesarian section on the day of assessment and 3 patients were waiting.

The Principal was not permitted by the Assessors to refute the comments made by the Assessors in the Assessment report.

We request you to kindly see that no injustice is done after going through our contention as we cannot confront the assessors with any type of arguments disrespecting their authority.

3. Faculty and Residents : Our College is located in the border of Andhra Pradesh (20 kms from KGF). On the day of Inspection Lok Sabha & Assembly Elections were going on in Andhra Pradesh. 5 faculty members and 5 residents who belonged to that State availed leave to cast their vote.

The declaration forms of those faculties and residents with proof of address and voter id cards is enclosed for your kind perusal. Hence, the availability of faculties are 111 Nos. (95%) and residents 63 Nos. (95%). Declaration forms attached. **Annexure - 3.**

We request you to kindly look into the matter and consider the above facts and explanation submitted by us and grant us the permission for the 4th batch (3rd renewal) of MBBS course at our College.
