1	Deficiency of faculty is 7.09% as detailed in the report.	The deficiency is within the permissible limits. However, the 16 identified faculty not accepted during the inspection for inadequacies in publications have been demoted with immediate effect. They were not permitted to be counted in lower designations though eligible. This issue has been rectified and including them will correct the deficiency.	Faculty deficiency 0.6% Resident deficiency- NIL
2	OPD: Teaching areas are small & inadequately furnished in the departments of General Medicine, General Surgery, O.G., Pediatrics, Orthopedics.	Our UG batches posted in clinical units remains like before; only 15 per batch despite increase to 150 seats. During OPD postings, like before the 15 students are further divided into smaller groups of 2-3 students per faculty and allocated to individual faculty consultation rooms for ambulatory teaching and enhanced exposure to patients in OPD. However, teaching areas of appropriate size for our batches have been identified and furnished.	In the major departments like Gen. Medicine, Gen. Surgery, OG, Paediatrics & Orthopaedics, a teaching room of 20 seating capacity have been made with teaching materials. Other allied departments also having teaching rooms.



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
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



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

3	<p>Wards :</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Distance between 2 beds is &lt; 1.5 m.</li> <li>They are in form of multiple small rooms each having 5 to 12 beds.</li> <li>They are not visible from Nursing station.</li> </ul> <p>Teaching areas are small with capacity of 6-8 students &amp; are inadequately furnished</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The College was started in 1963 and the hospital was built in 1970. The original 1960s design of the hospital had separate 6-10 bedded rooms for patient privacy in the common wards. It also helps for easy segregating of patients e.g. infected vs non infected, MRSA etc. No previous inspection had commented on the size of the wards. Further it is impossible to modify the wards now, particularly at short notice. In the existing wards we have spaced the beds (1.5 M) as required and placed a nurse substation in each ward, while maintaining a central nursing station.</li> <li>However, we are building a new 600 bedded common/ general ward block specifically designed with large 30 bed wards, 1.5 m spacing and a central nursing station as per norms.</li> <li>The MCI regulations have withdrawn the need for demonstration/teaching areas in the wards. Despite that, at the last inspection, an average of 2 large demonstration rooms and 2 smaller rooms in each department were shown. Despite that this was listed as a deficiency.</li> <li>The UG batches posted in clinical units remains like before; 15 per batch</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The distance between two beds is adequate. i.e. more than 1.50 mtrs.</li> <li>A new block has started functioning with most of the departments shifted there having adequate spacing.</li> <li>There are still few departments having small rooms but having proper space and with a nursing staff.</li> <li>Teaching areas are adequate and well furnished.</li> </ul>
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
  
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

5	Central Library: It is partially air-conditioned.	Our college is in existence from 1963 and being in the city of Bangalore never needed air-conditioning. Till 2017, this was never pointed out as a compliance issue. Soon after it was pointed out we did air condition the library and was noted as compliant in the following inspection. In this inspection again it has been pointed out as partly air conditioned. Being an old structure it is not possible to centrally air condition it. We have put adequate single units to air condition the whole complex in consultation with an expert. The library is	There are <b>10nos.</b> of 2 ton split ACs in the ground floor having internet access room and reference section. There are <b>6nos.</b> of 2 ton ACs in the first floor having reference section. The total area of central Library is 2420 sq.m.

  
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

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
  
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
  
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
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<b>Notes:</b>
<b>For purpose of working out the deficiency:</b>
(1) The deficiency of teaching faculty and Resident Doctors shall be counted separately.
<b>(A) For Teaching Faculty:</b>
(a) For calculating the deficiency of faculty, Prof., Assoc Prof., Asst. Prof & Tutor in respective departments shall be counted together.
(b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
(c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
(d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.
<b>(B) For Resident Doctors:</b>
(a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
(b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
(c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
(d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.
(2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/ city and run by the same management.
(3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations - 2000.




