They had submitted their leave applications, along with necessary testimonials. Their leave was duly sanctioned and they were officially permitted to leave the headquarters. (Their leave applications along with valid reasons for leave were submitted to the assessors at the time of assessment). 		Anesthesiology were not counted as they were busy in hospital work and presented late at the time of staff verification. Therefore the deficiency of residents was 11.5%, which actually is not true. Moreover since, after the inspection 16 additional Senior Residents in various departments have been appointed.  As per the Medical Council of India norms there are 61 Senior Residents and 78 Junior Residents i.e. a total of 139 Residents are required in all the departments for an annual intake of 150 students. We have a total of 66 Senior Residents and 205 Junior Residents in various departments. So at present all the departments' have Faculty, SR's and JR's as per the Medical Council of India norms. Therefore there is no shortage of residents in any department.	
2	OPD attendance is 780 on day of assessment against requirement of 1,200.	The OPD attendance on the day of assessment was shown to be 780. Actually the average daily OPD it is much more than that. The OPD attendance on the day of assessment was less because the assessment was on 3 <sup>rd</sup> and 4 <sup>th</sup> September 2014, which was during the Ganesh Festival Season. It may please be noted that Ganesh Festival is celebrated in a big way in Maharashtra and Pune in particular. It is because of the Ganesh festival that the OPD attendance was relatively less on the day of assessment. The average daily OPD in our hospital is around 1400 cases per day and this is as per the Medical Council of India norms. This can be verified by reports submitted earlier and also by the assessment report of various assessors who have come for Post graduate inspection. Further efforts are being taken to increase the overall clinical work load in the hospital including OPD, IPD, operative procedures, investigative workload etc.	On the day of assessment OPD attendance is 1383.

assessment which otherwise is more than 85%. This can again be verified by the previous reports and the records submitted to the Medical Council of India. Moreover the college and hospital have taken a number of initiatives to further enhance the bed occupancy. We are a part of Rajiv Gandhi Jeevandayee Arogya Yojana scheme for poor, Shahari Garib Yojana and many other social welfare schemes offered by the various government agencies. The college and hospital has entered into MOU with Government of Maharashtra and Pune Zilla Parishad as PPP (Public Private Partnership) initiatives under which the hospital will provide general as well as super specialty services like cancer surgery, joint replacement, cardiology services, dialysis etc. to the needy. The hospital has also entered into the agreement with District Blindness Control Scheme (DBCS). All these and other initiatives are helping to increase the bed occupancy. It may please be noted that average bed occupancy in the hospital is more than 85% and in some department it is actually more than 100%. It may please be noted that the assessors in their detailed report have mentioned that the average clinical workload is adequate and is as per the Medical Council of India norms, they have specifically pointed out that it may have been less on the days of


