(c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
(d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.
<b>(B) For Resident Doctors:</b>
(a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
(b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
(c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.




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(d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR.  
e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.

(2) A separate department of Dentistry/ Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/ city and run by the same management.

(3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations - 2000.

for compliance verification for Recognition of Hi-Tech Medical College & Hospital, Rourkela, the Assessors found certain new definition during course of inspection and disallowed many of our medical faculties.

The definition of incomplete declaration form in few cases was Principal's Attestation not done, few others were not having principal's stamp, hence they are incomplete and attracted disqualification of that particular faculty members, though the Principal is very much available along with the Assessors to sign any pending or missing signatures.

Like that very strangely eight of our faculty members are disqualified.

1. The Coordinator distributed the areas to be visited by the 3 members (Assessors) allotting himself the Non-Clinical and Para-Clinical sections of the institute. Dr. R.S Trivedi was assigned clinical side of the institute. Dr. Anshuman Naik, Associate Professor (Physiology) was entrusted by me to accompany Dr. Dasgupta for Non-Clinical and Para-Clinical sections of the

institute. The Coordinator, Dr. Dasgupta started his inspection and suddenly without any call from Dr. Trivedi (who was covering clinical side) abandoned his visit and joined clinical visit. As such the Non-Clinical and Para-Clinical were not visited by any members of the MCI team and the two assessors were covering O&G Dept separately.

2. Dr. Anshuman Naik, Assoc Prof, Physiology was accompanying, the coordinator Prof Dr. Dasgupta, He had already signed the attendance sheet but during head count verification of Physiology dept (which was taken up by the coordinator), Dr. Anshuman Naik was not entertained by Prof. Dasgupta for the reasons known to him saying that the candidate came late afternoon. It reflected as deficiency of one Assoc Prof. Physiology in the department of Physiology deliberately. This is a glaring example of premeditated bias which the coordinator showed in his approach of assessment.

3. Prof (Dr.) Anjula Binaykia, HOD Obs & Gyn has joined this institute 15.12.2017 and was present during head count. She had put her signature on attendance sheet supplied by the coordinator and even videography confirms that she was accompanying the assessors during his visit to O&G Dept. Surprisingly, the coordinator of MCI team Prof. Dasgupta refused to entertain her as Prof & HOD of Obs & Gyn saying that she was not seen by him in the department.

4. Few declaration forms, which were yet to be signed by me, were not accepted saying that they are incomplete. As it is a surprise visit the declaration forms were in the process of being signed by the authorities concerned (HOD & Principal). Due to surprise visit chaos in the institute is natural. Principal and HODs were directing and putting things in order for inspection by the MCI team and hence a few declaration forms were not (6/7 of Sr. Res / Jr. Res) signed by authorities, whom the coordinator refused to entertain, where as the Sr. Residents and Jr. Residents have put their signatures on the attendance sheet supplied by the coordinator.

5. Two Sr. Residents from Anaesthesiology department were in O.T from 9.30 AM to 12.30 PM. Before going to O.T they signed their attendance sheet. But when they reached at 12.30 PM for head count they were not entertained. As per O.T protocol, the Anaesthetists are supposed to be the last person leaving the O.T after operations. This should have been taken into consideration by the coordinators who is a Prof of Obs & Gyn. Sometimes protocols are relaxed in genuine cases.

6. The deficiency for Professor of Dentistry, shown by the Assessors in their report is not valid as per MCI letter no MCI-934(41/206-Med176187 dated 09.03.17 raising the faculty deficiency higher, without any genuine reason

7. Even during the Bed Occupancy Report calculation, only alternate patients are taken into consideration and arrived at 48% occupancy. Otherwise our occupancy is 78%. Our records also speak the same thing. I have also expressed by denial on the Assessors report stating "I don't agree. No deficiency of Faculties & Residents as they were not counted". "I am sorry that the prepared report is far from reality. As such the statement of the Assessors is not accepted".

Hence we kindly request your goodself to look into the matter and do the needful yourself.
