

(1) The deficiency of teaching faculty and Resident Doctors shall be counted separately.

(A) For Teaching Faculty:

- (a) For calculating the deficiency of faculty, Prof., Assoc Prof., Asst. Prof & Tutor in respective departments shall be counted together.
- (b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
- (c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
- (d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.

(B) For Resident Doctors:

- (a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
- (b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
- (c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
- (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR.
- e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.

At that time, we have asked them wether any point they wants to clarify with us, we are ready to discuss it, but dean has said that report is okay but only in one point he mentioned disagreement that faculty and residents deficiency is higher so, please count / accept those faculty and residents who have not accepted due to late reporting or incomplete declaration form or not eligible due to any other reason. We have shown them D.F. & late attendant sheet and explained why we have not accepted them as per MCI norms. We also asked them, if any remarks is there, please give us in writing. But authority has not signed the report as well as not given any remarks also. They have even not given acknowledgment receipt also. After 2 hours, we left the college after giving signed report to Dean without acknowledgement receipt.
- Clinical material of the hospital was very inadequate. Actually, indoor bed occupancy on the day of assessment at 10.00 AM was 26%. But we have counted / accepted / added those patients also who were not present in wards but gone for Laboratory and Radiological investigations, O.T.s , Cross reference etc., as claimed by staff nurses / doctors. So, final total beds occupancy on the day of assessment at 10.00 am was 34% (242 indoor out of 710 required beds)

(written statement of these residents in attendant sheet attached) are not counted.





At the same time, other two MCI Inspectors had gone for Inspection in the Hospital in various Departments and hence the Faculty of the concerned Departments had gone along with them. Soon a big crowd was there in the Lecture Hall at 10.30 am. So, we couldn't able to recognize whether all the faculty members of various departments have signed attendance sheet or not. By 10.45 am only we found that the faculty members of General Surgery & Ophthalmology were not signed and we informed them. Inspectors have agreed to accept surgeons who were in the operation theatre, post operative ward, ICU, SICU, General wards and in OPD. The Hospital is 100 meters away from the college. When the faculty members of General Surgery &

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Ophthalmology came to college block at that time the MCI Inspector completed the attendance exactly by 11.00 am and he went for Inspection to Library and Hostels.

Since the attendance was carried out both Pre, Para, Clinical departments in the college block, there was lot of confusion because of that faculty of Surgery & Ophthalmology have not signed the attendance sheet except those who were in the theatre and those who were accompanied by Inspectors. Because of that it was not possible for us to show 100% attendance. This can be verified from our Bio-metric attendance which was taken on 17.07.2017 at 8.30 am.

The list of Faculty Members who were not present between 10.00 am and 11.00 am at the Lecture Hall, but they all registered in the Biometric system at 8.00 am on 17th July 2017 are enclosed herewith for your kind perusal and further action.

Bed occupancy on the day of Assessment as given in the MCI Assessor report as 274/710 (38.59%).

- 1. About 30 in patients (IP) were shifted to Operation theatres, about 30 in patients (IP) for Pre Anaesthetic Assessment and 40 in patients (IP) gone for cross references, remaining 30 in patients for Radiological Investigations & Lab Investigations. Hence, 130 in patients (IP) were not in the ward so not counted at the time of Inspection by the Assessor.
- 2. Yesterday (17.07.2017) was a local Adi festival day in Pondicherry so in patient load was decreased but today (18.07.2017) it has been increased to 75%.
