

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



1	Deficiency of faculty is 19.58 % as detailed in the report.	<p>(i). Deficiency of faculty was 4% at this institution on the day of Assessment, which is within the norms of Medical Council of India.</p> <p>(ii). The Assessor did not listen the legitimate clarifications given by the Principal and refused to accept the faculty who were on duly sanctioned leave. Leave applications were submitted to the Assessors.</p> <p>(iii). As per the assessment report dated 14.09.2017 page No 19 and 20 9 (Nine) faculty members have not been counted by assessor as they came late, in this connection it was submitted to the assessor that they had rushed to home to bring their original certificates. The assessor declined to entertain them and were not allowed to mark their attendance. 14 faculty members were on duly approved leave. Valid leave record were shown to the assessor who declined to accept. 4 (Four) faculty members as per detail were on evening/night duty as per roster which was shown to the assessors:</p>	Deficiency of faculty is 5.59 % (8 out of 143)

2	Shortage of Residents is 22.36 % as detailed in the report.	<p>Senior Resident :- There is no Deficiency of Senior Residents. 4 (Four) Senior Residents were not counted as they did not have their original documents at the time of inspection as listed in para 7 of page 20 of the assessment report dated 14.09.2017.</p> <p>Junior Resident:- There is no deficiency of Junior Residents. 01 Junior Resident was not counted as she did not have her original documents at the time of assessment. 14 Junior Residents were not counted as they were on shift duty (02:00 PM to 08:00 PM and 08:00 PM to 08:00 AM) and those who had left the department at 08:00 AM after performing night shift duty on the day of assessment. <i>Hence, there is no deficiency</i></p>	Shortage of residents was observed to be 19.75 % (16 out of 81). On verification of hostel about 12 residents rooms were persistently closed. On verification with the Dean the third time at 8 pm, they were still closed (Videographic Evidence attached-).


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

Verified by assessors and Dean</p> <p>The resident hostels were spread over 4 floors in the hospital building.</p> <p>On the 6th floor of hospital building , rooms which were allotted to Residents, it was observed that most of the rooms were occupied by nursing staff- For example In 7205- the room was allotted to Dr. Manpreet Kaur, JR in Psychiatry. However on physical verification by all three assessors it was verified that the room was occupied by Mrs. Susan Mathew, Professor of Nursing . (Evidence in the form of Video and signed papers enclosed) In 7212, room allotted to Dr. Baneet Kamboj, JR Surgery, but nurse staff Amandeep is residing. (Evidence enclosed)</p> <p>On the 5th Floor, in room no 6217, the room was shown as allotted to Dr. Gurpreet Singh, SR, however on verification it was observed that it was occupied by Dr.Pradeep Sharma, Associate Professor, Obstetrics and Gynec and his family (Videographic evidence enclosed) On the 4th floor, in room no 5214, Dr. Nimish Garg, JR Medicine are not staying as verified by the assessors. 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4	Bed Occupancy at 10 a.m. on day of assessment is 13.38 %.	<p>The Bed Occupancy was low on the day of assessment due to reasons mentioned below:-</p> <p>i. <u>Baba Ram Rahim Episode</u>: After the conviction of Baba Ram Rahim in dual rape case in a Panchkula Court on 25.08.2017 and 28.08.2017 there was total breakdown of law and order and anarchy in the entire state of Punjab Haryana, and NCR. As per official record, more than 30 persons (300 plus unofficially) were shot dead and hundreds were wounded by police firing in different parts of the State. The internet service, highways, railways, mobile massaging services were suspended and curfew was imposed in most of the parts of the state for more than 10 days. Even the MBBS admission process which was supposed to be completed by 31.08.2017 had to be rescheduled by Hon'ble Supreme Court on request by the State Govt. to 04.09.2017 due to break down of law and order situation in the State. News paper clips are enclosed at annexure-I.</p> <p>ii. On 16.09.2017, there was again appearance of the same convicted Baba in Court for the trial of Murder Case and there was fear psychosis of breakdown of law and order situation again in the state and Section 144 of IPC, as Bathinda being adjacent to Sirsa is highly sensitive.</p>	<p>Bed Occupancy at 10 a.m. on day of assessment is 40.15% (267 out of 665 teaching beds) Evidence sheets signed by nursing staff and Medical Superintendent enclosed</p>
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		<p>iii. The assessors visited the hospital alone. They denied company of any authority of the institution. As such, they might have visited/ not visited certain areas of the hospital which can be a reason of inaccuracy in counting bed occupancy. The OPD on day of assessment was 1433 and was authenticated by the assessors in assessment report itself.</p> <p>iv. It is note worthy that Nil deficiency of clinical material was found in surprise inspection for MBBS on 25.04.2017 and surprise inspections conducted by 9 different Assessor for nine PG courses simultaneously on 09.08.2017 before the said Ram Rahim episode.</p> <p>v. The IPD strength has been directly and adversely affected due to above facts.</p> <p>vi. The average bed occupancy has since been restored to normal. <i>Hence, there is no deficiency</i></p>

Subject: Assessment of the physical and other teaching facilities available for continuance of recognition of MBBS degree (150 seats) granted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences, Faridkot, Punjab in respect of students being trained at Adesh Institute of Medical Sciences and Research, Bathinda u/s 19 of the IMC, Act 1956.

Sir/ Madam,

In reference to the above, an assessment was carried out on 17-18 May 2016 for continuation of recognition. It was perceived during the said assessment that certain deficiencies and disparities were recorded by the assessors which were not in consonance with the facts on ground. Verbal as well as written clarifications were also submitted by the Principal during the assessment process but the same do not appear to have been taken into consideration by the Assessors. The same clarifications are re-submitted herewith as per succeeding paragraphs for kind consideration of concerned authorities.

1. CLINICAL MATERIAL / BED OCCUPANCY:

Due to on-going harvesting / sowing seasons in the region and intense heat ranging from 45° to 48° C in the on-going summer season, the bed occupancy was 55% on the day of assessment whereas it was shown as 19.69% by the assessors. In this connection, it was felt that the assessors did not take into consideration the following facts also which were demonstrated to them:

(a) A large number patients had been shifted from upper floors to lower floors of the hospital due to intense heat, for eg. 20 patients of the Obstetrics Ward on the 5th floor were shifted to Maternity Unit on the Ground floor, hence some unoccupied beds on upper floors.

(b) The bed occupancy taken into consideration was at 10.30 AM. However, most discharged patients leave early in the morning and new patients come to the wards after 12.00 N after investigations and completion of formalities for admission, hence some unoccupied beds at the time of inspection.

(c) The patients in operation theatres / pre medication / recovery areas were not taken into consideration by the assessors.

(d) Large number of patients insist on day care surgery and procedure and / or decline to stay in the hospital for post-operative care/ after procedures even when admitted in the hospital possibly due to lack of attendant support from the family busy in harvesting. Further, a large number of general surgical procedures / eye surgical procedures / ENT procedures / Skin procedures / Gynae procedures are done as out-patient due to advent of endoscopic / laparoscopic techniques. Some wards were locked having been fumigated overnight.

2. DEFICIENCY OF FACULTY / TUTORS:

13 (thirteen) faculty members and 24 (twenty four) tutors out of 134 have been shown as deficient by the assessors in the draft report. In this connection, it is submitted that only 5 faculty members were deficient out of 134 as outlined below:

(a) Tutor / Demonstrators:

Fourteen (14) PG students in the various departments of Basic Sciences (Pharmacology-1, Pathology-6, Microbiology-3, Community Medicine-4) were not accepted as Tutors / Demonstrators although they were present for reasons best known to the assessors. Representation regarding that was also handed over to the assessors on the spot vide this office letter no. AIMS/RC/Estt./05/2k16/2532 dated 18.05.2016 (Copy enclosed as Annexure-I).

Thirteen (13) Demonstrators / Tutors (and 12 Junior Residents) were on legitimate leave for participation in the PG Counselling conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences at Faridkot on 17th to 19th May 2016 (Copy of the Notification published by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences is enclosed as Annexure-II).

(b) Faculty members:

Five (5) faculty members [Gynae-2, Paediatrics-2, Surgery-1] and 3 (three) Senior Residents [Medicine-2, Surgery-1] were on duty at Civil Hospital Raman and Sub Divisional Hospital Talwandi Sabo (District Bathinda) as per standing instruction of the Govt. of Punjab, Department of Health & Family Welfare (Health Branch-I) vide letter no. 23/04/2016-1c/691408/1 dated 17.02.2016 (Copy is enclosed as Annexure-III).

Four (4) faculty members [3 Professors and 1 Associate Professor] were on duty at Delhi as a part of the delegation led by Hon'ble Vice Chancellor of Adesh University Bathinda for a meeting in Department of Bio Technology, Govt. of India in connection with Joint Collaborative Research Project of Adesh University Bathinda, Banaras Hindu University and SRM University, Chennai scheduled for 17th and 18th May 2016. They were not counted by assessors. (Copy of relevant documents in this regard are enclosed herewith as Annexure-IV).

3. DEFICIENCY OF RESIDENTS:

28 Residents (19 Senior Residents and 9 Junior Residents) have been shown as deficient whereas the true position is as under:

(a) 12 Junior Residents were on legitimate leave for participation in the PG Counselling conducted by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences at Faridkot on 17th to 19th May 2016 (Copy of the

Notification published by Baba Farid University of Health Sciences is enclosed as Annexure-II) as already mentioned in Para 2(a) above.

(b) 3 Senior Residents (Medicine-2, Surgery-1) were on duty at Civil Hospital Raman and Sub Divisional Hospital Talwandi Sabo (District Bathinda) as per standing instruction of the Govt. of Punjab, Department of Health & Family Welfare (Health Branch-I) vide letter no. 23/04/2016-1c/691408/1 dated 17.02.2016 (Copy is enclosed as Annexure-III) as already mentioned in Para 2(b) above.

(c) Sixteen (16) Senior Residents were present but not accepted on the ground of their address being of local at Bathinda but outside the campus, in spite of representation that they all have been allotted rooms in the hospital where they stay during their entire duration of duty as per roster. However, since they are permanent residents of Bathinda city, their permanent address were shown as Bathinda as per record and they were allowed to stay in Bathinda City when not on duty.

In view of the above, it is requested that the above submission and clarifications regarding the alleged disparities/ deficiencies may kindly be taken into consideration along with the assessors' report regarding continuation of recognition of this institution.

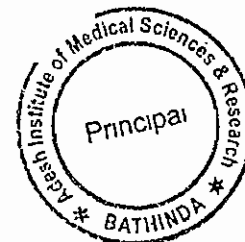
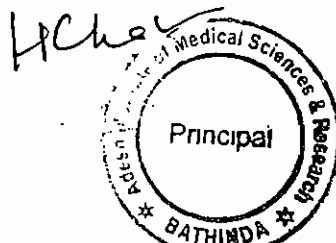
1. This is regarding the MCI inspection held on 17th-18th May 2016 at Adesh Institute of Medical Sciences & Research, Bathinda.
2. We are having Resident Postgraduate students in the pre-clinical and para-clinical subjects, and considered them as demonstrator as per MEDICAL COUNCIL OF INDIA Minimum Qualifications for Teachers in Medical Institutions Regulations, 1998 (AMENDED UPTO MAY, 2015) which states as quote "qualification of Tutor/ Demonstrator/Resident/ Registrar as MBBS/M.Sc. Medical in subject concerned) for nonmedical persons." Unquote.
3. All these Resident Postgraduate students are possessing MBBS qualification and accordingly they were designated as demonstrators.
4. The teaching experience of Assistant Professor as per the above cited document is, quote "For the candidates possessing MD/MS degree from MCI recognized medical college. Three years teaching experience in the subject as Resident/ Registrar/ Demonstrator/ Tutor in a recognized medical college either during the post-graduation course or after obtaining postgraduate degree in the subject."
5. The stated facts above clearly depict that a postgraduate student is counted against the post of Demonstrator.
6. However, the worthy members of the inspection team have refused to count Resident postgraduate students as demonstrators.
7. So hereby, we request to your good-self, to consider our representation and re-calculate our strength of teaching-staff, in view of the facts mentioned above.
