The shortage of Resident Doctors shown as 50.74% by the assessors is based on the rejection of 34 residents out of 67 which includes total 14 excess residents. Thus the shortage of Residents is purely based on their continuous non-stay in the Resident Quarters which is,20i.e (20/67= 29.8%).

As all the Residents were physically present at the time of surprise assessment and have signed in the presence of the coordinator before 11.00 am and at the time of head count, the deficiency calculated because of the non-stay in quarters by few residents may be treated as rectified and the deficiency, whereby drop recognition of the Institution and career of 100 girls students will be in jeopardy and stake as they are completing their compulsory internship by March 2016 and also they are appearing for P.G. Entrance Test.

The proof of all the Residents who have signed before 11.00 am in the presence of the assessors is already sent to MCI by the assessors.

Hence the deficiency is rectified.

The Assessors have taken into account the new admissions, only upto 10.00 am. As it was a surprise assessment, the question of filling non-genuine patients does not arise since those patients were admitted before arrival of assessment team.

The total IPD/ Bed Occupancy recorded by the assessors is 371 i.e (78.9%) which includes these 68 new admissions.

As recorded by the assessors, that, "Many Patients admitted on the day of inspection not for genuine reasons". i.e. of the 68 patients admitted on the day of assessment, the assessors felt that some of them are admitted not for genuine reasons. As a matter of fact the admissions were made prior to the entry of assessment team in the Hospital.

Even otherwise, the difference of admitted patients and just discharged patients on the day of assessment at 10.00 am is 68-62= 6.

(1) The deficiency of teaching faculty and Resident Doctors shall be counted separately.

#### (A) For Teaching Faculty:

- (a) For calculating the deficiency of faculty, Prof., Assoc Prof., Asst. Prof & Tutor in respective departments shall be counted together.
- (b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
- (c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
- (d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.

#### (B) For Resident Doctors:

- (a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
- (b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
- (c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
- (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.
- (2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/city and run by the same management.
- (3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations 2000.

- b) In the library there is no inside & outside students reading room. There is only one 180 seating capacity reading room. Staff reading room & Resident reading room are inadequate. Librarian could not demonstrate a large number of books entered in the registers. The no. of Indian & foreign Journals are before & of the year 2013. The no. of Journals are less than the requirement.
- c) The Residents Hostel is poorly furnished. The Resident & Nursing Hostels have been made in the top floor of the Hosp: building with aluminum partitions. Nearly all the rooms of the Residents Hostels were found to be vacant. The accommodation provided for Residents & Nurses is not as per MCI norms. Messing facility is not available in the Resident & Nursing Hostel. No visitors room or study room is provided in the Interns & Nursing Hostel. Toilets facilities are Inadequate.
