The report of the assessors also confirms the same. However, some of the residents who are preparing for the P.G. Entrance scheduled on 28-2-2016, and who are residing in the closet vicinity of the College are refusing to stay in the campus and thereby the College has appointed additional 10 SRs and 4 JRs to overcome this problem making a total of 81 Residents (34 SR's and 47 JR's) against the minimum requirement of 67 (24 SR's and 43 JR's). All the Residents are provided the accommodation which is also confirmed in the assessment report.</p> <p>Of the total 81 Residents available at the time of assessment , 34 Residents are not counted and shown as not available, inspite of their presence, based on the reason that, they are not continuously staying in the Resident's Quarters, whereas 47 Residents were found to be staying in the Resident Quarters.</p> <p>The shortage of Resident Doctors shown as</p>	<p>Shortage of Residents (36 out of 67 i.e. 53.73 %) is not rectified. 		<p>Quarters.</p> <p>The shortage of Resident Doctors shown as 50.74% by the assessors is based on the rejection of 34 residents out of 67 which includes total 14 excess residents. Thus the shortage of Residents is purely based on their continuous non-stay in the Resident Quarters which is, 20 i.e. <math>(20/67 = 29.8\%)</math>.</p> <p>As all the Residents were physically present at the time of surprise assessment and have signed in the presence of the coordinator before 11.00 am and at the time of head count, the deficiency calculated because of the non-stay in quarters by few residents may be treated as rectified and drop the deficiency, whereby the recognition of the Institution and career of 100 girls students will be in jeopardy and stake <i>as they are completing their compulsory internship by March 2016 and also they are appearing for P.G. 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

The total IPD/ Bed Occupancy recorded by the assessors is 371 i.e (78.9%) which includes these 68 new admissions.


As recorded by the assessors,that, "Many Patients admitted on the day of inspection not for genuine reasons". i.e. of the 68 patients admitted on the day of assessment, the assessors felt that some of them are admitted not for genuine reasons. As a matter of fact the admissions were made prior to the entry of assessment team in the Hospital.

Even otherwise, the difference of admitted patients and just discharged patients on the day of assessment at 10.00 am is  $68-62= 6$ .

(b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only.
(c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
(d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.
<b>(B) For Resident Doctors:</b>
(a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.

- c) The Residents Hostel is poorly furnished. The Resident & Nursing Hostels have been made in the top floor of the Hosp: building with aluminum partitions. Nearly all the rooms of the Residents Hostels were found to be vacant. The accommodation provided for Residents & Nurses is not as per MCI norms. Messing facility is not available in the Resident & Nursing Hostel. No visitors room or study room is provided in the Interns & Nursing Hostel. Toilets facilities are Inadequate.
