The reports are received from Central Pathology Lab and Department of Radiology twice a day. On the day of Inspection majority of reports were received in the afternoon. Before the reports are received a provisional diagnosis is written on the case files to which the Assessors have mentioned as “non specific minor ailments”. A final diagnosis is established after the lab and radiological investigations are received.</p> <p>We are not in agreement that 40% of patients in Medical Department were admitted for minor complaints. The final diagnosis of patients was arrived at after the investigations reports were received in the afternoon. 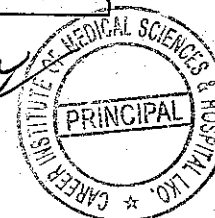

The Assessors calculated it as 77%. The observation by Assessor that patients were admitted for minor complaints is not agreeable. Only the genuine cases are admitted in hospital which is also the basic requirement of Undergraduate teaching. The list of cases with final diagnosis are attached (Annexure-II).	Bed occupancy is 81%. In female orthopaedic wards some patients were admitted with minor ailments.

1	Shortage of Residents is 22.72 as detailed in the report.	<p>77 Residents were available on the day of Inspection against the requirement of 66 (24 SR & 42 JR). One JR was not considered as his salary slip was not available with him. Salary slip is now available with JRs. 25 residents were not considered because they were not available in the rooms allotted to them. 15 (22.72%) shown as deficient are also among the same 25 residents. As far as the accommodation in Residents hostels is concerned; we have accommodation for 116 residents (58x2). The rooms had already been allotted which were authenticated by the Assessors. In order to ensure their stay in Residents hostels we have taken the affidavit from Residents.</p> <p>Thus more than 100% J.R.s and S.R.s were actually available on the day of inspection out of which 15 Residents (22.72%) out of 66 Residents were not staying in the hostel and were not counted. Since, it has been ensured that henceforth, they will be available in hostel beyond duty hours. Hence, no deficiency is there.</p>	Residents deficiency is 3.03% & Faculty deficiency is 5.88%.
