Deficiency of faculty is 14.46 % as detailed in the report.	<p>The faculty deficiency as per assessors report is as under:- Deficiency of Teaching Faculty: 14.46% (23 out of 159) (5 Faculty + 18 Tutors) Assessors report dated 24.04.2017 at page no. 19 enclosed as <u>Annexure – I.</u></p> <p>The deficiency of faculty was mainly because 18 PG students, who were present and appointed as tutors were not considered as tutors during this inspection. In the Pre and Para Clinical departments all the PG students are appointed as Tutors. In the MCI Inspection on 14 & 15th February 2017, PG students were duly considered and counted as Tutors (Assessors report dated 14 & 15.02.2017 page No. 38 enclosed as <u>Annexure – II.</u> As per MCI Minimum Qualification for Teachers in Medical Institutions Regulation 1998 amended upto 11th March, 2017 for appointment as Assistant Professor/Lecturer the MCI regulations clearly state that “Three years teaching experience in the subject as Resident/Registrar/Demonstrator/Tutor in a recognized medical college either during the post-graduation course or after</p>	<p>(1) Faculty 1.24% (2 out of 161)</p> <p>(2) Residents 1.14% (1 out of 87)</p>


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

Therefore if the PG Students are considered as Tutors, the deficiency comes out to 3.14% (5/159) which is within the permissible limit of MCI. Now we have appointed 18 additional tutors. The declaration forms & appointment orders are enclosed (as Annexure – IV).	
2.	A significant chunk of patients in Medicine, Skin & VD, Psychiary & Paediatrics wards were such who did not require hospitalization at all.	Patients come to this institution from far off places and sometimes patients with minor and vague complaints get admitted at odd hours. Patients in various specialties (Medicine, Psychiatry, Skin & VD etc.) are admitted from OPD on working diagnosis arrived at, by considering their symptoms and findings. These patients are worked up later on and final diagnosis and plan of treatment is made. Few patients who may not require stay in the hospital are discharged after counseling and advice.	Rectified
3.	The list of patients who did not require hospitalization is as under:- Medicine Wards:- 1. Khusbu – Fever, No investigations since admission, No resident posted in ward could give history. 2. Jag Deyi – Vague complaints	The assessors probably saw only the file cover where working diagnosis was written. Final diagnosis is arrived at after investigations and complete workup and then the case summary is written on file cover at the time of discharge. Few patients might not have been able to describe their complaints properly and the symptoms are written verbatim by the residents.	On verification during rounds the bed occupancy is around 79.16%.



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

(b) Any excess teaching faculty in higher cadre can compensate the deficiency of lower cadre of the same department only. (c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor. (d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.
(B) For Resident Doctors:
(a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only. (b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department. (c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department. (d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.
(2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/city and run by the same management.


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

Out of a total strength of 85 Residents working in the Institution only 6 Senior Residents could not appear in the Inspection as they were on sanctioned leave, their leave applications along with their declaration forms are being enclosed as Annexure - V .	2.36% is the deficiency of Residents.
3	Bed Occupancy was 36.62% at 10 a.m. on day of assessment.	As noted in the dissent note on 17.03.2017 in the Assessors report [Part A-II (2017-18) page No. 21] the bed occupancy percentage on first day was (80.13%) at Annexure - VI duly verified by the Medical Superintendent and Dean. The assessors have not considered patients who had gone for investigations, minor and major surgical operations and for check up in other departments. Patients who were not counted as per Assessors chart and had gone for multiple investigations in the various laboratories, (253 for Pathology/Microbiology/Hematology, 10 for USG, 5 CT Scan, 10 for MRI and 37 for X-ray) and for minor and major surgical operations and check-up.	82.36% but a significant chunk of patients in Medicine wards, Dermatology wards, Psychiatry wards, Pediatrics wards are such as do not require hospitalization at all considering this institute is imparting post-graduate training. The Executive Committee, after due deliberation and discussion, has decided that the college has failed to comply with the stipulation laid down by the Oversight Committee. Accordingly, the Executive Committee recommends that as per the directions passed by Oversight Committee in para 3.2(b) vide communication dated 13/08/2016 the college should be debarred from admitting students in the above course for a period of two academic years i.e. 2017-18 & 2018-19 as even after giving an undertaking that they have fulfilled the entire infrastructure for the award of MBBS degree granted by Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Rohilkhand University, Bareilly against the increased intake i.e. from 100 to 150 seats u/s 11(2) of the IMC Act, 1956 and Compliance Verification Assessment for renewal of permission for admission of 5th batch of MBBS students against the increased intake i.e. from 100 to 150 seats u/s 10 A of the IMC Act, 1956 for the academic year 2016-17, the college was found to be grossly deficient. It has also been decided by the Executive Committee that the Bank Guarantee furnished by the college in pursuance of the directives passed by the Oversight Committee as well as GOI letter dated 20/08/2016 is liable to be encashed.

(c) Any excess teaching faculty of lower cadre/ category in any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in the higher cadre/ category of the same department or any other department. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of Associate Professor or Professor.
(d) Excess/Extra teaching faculty of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of any teaching faculty in any other department.
(B) For Resident Doctors:
(a) Excess of SR can be compensated to the deficiency of JR of the same department only.
(b) Excess SR/JR of any department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR in any other department.
(c) Any excess of JR cannot compensate the deficiency of SR in same or any other department.
(d) Any excess/ extra teaching faculty of same or any other department cannot compensate the deficiency of SR/JR. e.g. excess of Assistant Professor cannot compensate the deficiency of SR or JR.
(2) A separate department of Dentistry/Dental faculty is not required where a dental college is available in same campus/ city and run by the same management.
(3) Colleges running PG program require additional staff, beds & other requirements as per the PG Regulations - 2000.
