

Dr. Kalra is MDS from Government Dental College & Research Institute, Bangalore in May, 2013 (Annexure-3). He has been accepted in the previous two MCI inspections on 30.8.16 and 17.4.17 (Annexure-3). Since 1.6.16, he has been working here as Assistant Professor on the virtue of his acceptance in the previous two MCI inspections (copy of 30.8.16 enclosed while the 17.4.17 was a compliance inspection, hence the copy is not available on your website but that can be verified from your records). I have made this observation on Page no 34 of the assessor's report (Annexure-4) also against the non-acceptability of the teaching faculty. Therefore, if he is accepted the deficiency of faculty will be further reduced to 8.49%. Referring to the gazette notification dated 8.6.17 dated Pg No. 304/305 S No C Point No 1 where it is clearly mentioned that Post graduate qualification must be from a recognized college (He has passed out MDS from Government Dental College & Research Institute, Bangalore in May, 2013). Dr. Deepesh Jaiswal, Associate Professor, Dentistry has not been accepted because he doesn't have 3 years experience from medical college vide MCI Minimum Qualification for Teachers (Amended up to 8th June, 2017 (Same as Annexure-2). Dr. Jaiswal has a total of 4 years Senior lecturer/Assistant Professor. Out of these 4 years, 01 year 03 month from 30.06.2011 to 06.10.2012 was served in Institute of Dental Sciences, Bareilly having Rohailkhand Medical College in the same campus (Annexure-5).
